Bears are amazing to behold. But unless you are really brave and good at playing dead, we recommend you do your bear viewing through a trained outfitter like Frontiers North Adventures. From their base in Churchill, Canada (a remote area home to more than 900 polar bears), the eco-conscious tour company offers trips that go around the Hudson Bay and up north to neighboring Elu Inlet and Igloodik to view grizzly, black, and polar bears as well as musk ox, caribou, whales, walruses, seals, and other Arctic creatures. One of the best ways to get up close and personal in October and November is in the company's famed Tundra Buggy Lodge – which is kind of like an Amtrak/Hummer hybrid that parks 38 guests in the thick of the wild. Pretty cool stuff. But trips sell out quickly, so if you want on that buggy, better boogie.
